Rev Black was admitted for ultrasound guided liver biopsy. His CT's scans were discussed at our x-ray meeting and it was felt that there was a possible focal lesion in segment 5. This area was identified with ultrasound and two cores of ssue were taken. Unfortunately pathology of these specimens confirms _epato-cellular carcinoma.

As yet we have not informed Rev Black of the findings at biopsy but will arrange for him to attend the transplant clinic on the 5th June to discuss results. In the meant ime we will discuss again with the radiologists and our surgical eqlleagues as to the prospect of radio frequency ablation or chemo-embolisation.
