Liver transplant for hepatitis C with incidental HCC 1996
Previous haemophilia A
Hepato-cellular carcinoma in graft

Rev Black was admitted for ultrasound guided liver biopsy. His CT's scans were discussed at our x-ray meeting and it was felt that there was a possible focal lesion in segment 5. This area was identified with ultrasound and two cores of tissue were taken. Unfortunately pathology of these specimens confirms Hepato-cellular carcinoma.

As yet we have not informed Rev Black of the findings at biopsy but will arrange for him to attend the transplant clinic on the 5th June to discuss results. In the meantime we will discuss again with the radiologists and our surgical colleagues as to the prospect of radio frequency ablation or chemo-embolisation.
