DIAGNOSIS;

1. Liver transplant for hepatitis C - April 1996
2. Previous haemophillia
3. Recurrent Hep C

I reviewed this gentleman in clinic this morning. He is doing very well with no restrictions on his physical activities. He is thinking about moving to Stirling to be closer to one of his sons. This is by no means certain.

His Liver enzymes today are similar to previously with an ALT 127, GTT 148 with normal Alk Phos and Albumin. Tacrolimus level was 6 which is satisfactory, and he will carry on with 1.5 mg per day. His Urea is 7.4, normal Creatinine and U&E's. His Glucose is on the slightly high side at 9.7 and we will check this again when he comes in for his annual biopsy on 23rd April.
