This gentleman with haemophilia A was reviewed in the Clinic on 24 09 91. He has been doing reasonably well with no further GI bleeds since he was last seen by your team in November 1990. He is known to have oesophageal varices with mild hepatic derangement presumably secondary to hepatitis C as a consequence of the blood products he received over the years for his haemophilia.

He is planning to go to USA soon and he awaits an appointment for an upper GI endoscopy check up and we would be grateful if this could be arranged at your convenience.
