Re: David Black 23 Park Avenue Bishopbriggs DOB 1.5.37

I reviewed this man at the Haemophiliac Out-patient Clinic. As you know he suffers from haemophilia A, his most recent factor VIII level is 3% however clinically he is mild. His teeth are in good condition and he attends the Dental Hospital regularly. His only other problem is his right knee which occasionally locks and gives and on examination he certainly had some mild crepitus suggestive of some underlying arthritis. He also complains of low back pain on occasion.

On examination he was well and BP was 110/70, pulse 64, CVS intact and there was no lymphadenopathy and no splenomegaly evident. Overall he appeared well and we have arranged to review him in one year's time at the clinic. Routine bloods revealed a haemoglobin of 14 gms%, liver function tests normal.
