Reverend Black was admitted on the 20th April 1996 for elective liver transplantation. His immediate post operative recovery was good and after a short spell in intensive care and the high dependency unit he was transferred to the main ward of the Transplant Unit.

Subsequent to that he developed fluid retention peripherally ~~in the form of~~ *as well as* ascites. A diagnostic ascitic tap indicated evidence of spontaneous bacterial peritonitis which was treated successfully with Ciprofloxacin and the diagnostic tap thereafter was negative. His peripheral fluid retention responded well to a small dose of Frusemide.

Upon discharge, Reverend Black looked well with no pallor or jaundice and no leg swelling. His abdomen showed moderate ascites but no tenderness and the rest of the examination was unremarkable.

His liver function tests were more or less normal and his LFTs showed bilirubin 16 μ mol/l, ALT 52 units/l, GGT 68 units/l, alkaline phosphatase 90 units/litre and albumin 38 g/l. Full blood count showed Hb 95, wcc 2.9, platelets 196. His methioprine has been stopped.

Drugs on discharge -

viscon
statin
nitidine 150 mg bd
metoprolol 10 mls when required



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Cotrimoxazole 480 mg alternate days
Tacrolimu 4 mg twice a day

Reverend Black will be reviewed again in the Transplant Clinic on the 22nd May 1996.
