## Diagnosis:

1. Liver transplant for hepatitis C cirrhosis - April 1996
2. Five small HCC in explanted liver (undiagnosed pre transplant)
3. Previous haemophilia
4. Abnormal liver function tests secondary to recurrent hepatitis C

David Black was admitted for liver biopsy to investigate his abnormal liver function tests. This was performed under ultrasound control as he had not had an ultrasound scan performed since his transplant. Ultrasound scanning showed no focal lesion within the liver, normal appearance of the biliary tree and normal hepatic vein, portal vein and hepatic artery. Liver biopsy was performed uneventfully. Prior to biopsy his factor 8 levels were checked as a precaution and were found to be 0.94 (normal range 0.5 - 1.5).

Revisonal report from liver biopsy shows changes compatible with recurrent hepatitis C.

Whilst on the ward he was also seen by our dermatologist and found to have two basal cell carcinoma's, one on his left forehead and one on his upper back. Dr Anton, Consultant Dermatologist intends to refer him to the local dermatologist at Law Hospital for removal of these. I would be grateful if you could check that these arrangements are in hand.

I will review him again in the out-patient clinic in 2 months time.
