I understand this patient has recently come on your list. He has been known to me for some time and has attended for the investigation of a bleedig disorder. The various haemostatic tests have not been completely in agreement and the diagnosis has rested between Von Willebrand's Disease and Haemophilia. The present evidence points to a diagnosis of Haemophilia with a F VIII level of .3 units per ml. He does not appear to have any problems, except when faced with a haemostatic change and should this occur he requires active F VIII replacement therapy. I will be pleased to see him if there are any problems.
