This patient was referred to me this week, following his return to this country. He was known to us in the past, and was regarded as suffering from haemophilia. I understand that he was recently in the Stanford Medical Centre, where a diagnosis of von Willebrand's Disease was made. I also understand from him that you arranged investigations and I should be grateful if you could give me a summary of your findings, as this will save a lot of unnecessary repetitive investigations.

When I saw him this week his bleeding time by the Ivy Method was normal and his Factor VIII level 3% and Factor IX 71%.
