**Diagnosis:** HCV positive from blood transfusion 1992  
Colonic cancer resected 1993  
Nausea and vomiting settled (Helicobacter eradicated)  
Gynaecomastia

I saw this man at the clinic today. He feels well with no nausea or vomiting. His breast pain has decreased. I note that he had a liver biopsy back in 1996, which suggested fibrosis and it is conceivable that he has now progressed on to cirrhosis. It may be that the Gynaecomastia is associated with the cirrhosis. He has no abdominal or ankle swelling and feels well and therefore there is no indication for any further intervention at present. I have checked his bloods, including a coagulation screen and arranged to review him back in 6 months time.
