Axial sections through the upper abdomen, precontrast and in the arterial and venous phases of contrast enhancement.

The liver is small and irregular. However no focal lesion is seen within it on any of the phases of contrast enhancement.

The portal and splenic veins are patent. The spleen is not enlarged. There is a moderate amount of ascites. Multiple gallstones in the gallbladder but no biliary dilatation.

There is a small hiatus hernia. Apart from a simple cyst and a small stone in the lower pole of the left kidney, the kidneys are normal. Normal pancreas.

Conclusion: No radiological evidence, at present, of hepatoma.
