Clinical History: Lesion in head of pancreas, complex, severe pancreatitis.

CT PANCREAS: There is, as noted on the ultrasound, pronounced hepatosplenomegaly.

In addition, there are extensive varices present. Some of these are entwining around the pancreas and would account for the appearances on ultrasound.

There is no evidence of a pancreatic mass.

The left kidney is slightly malpositioned, but the kidneys are otherwise normal.

There is a moderate amount of ascites.

No other abnormality has been demonstrated.

There is pronounced cardiomegaly with multi-chamber enlargement. The lung bases are clear.
