FINDINGS:

Oesophagus - gastro-oesophageal junction 40 cm. Two small colums of varices proximal

to this at 3 and 6 o'clock No stigmata of recent bleeding.

Stomach - normal stomach

Duodenum - normal

CONCLUSION:

This lady has evidence of portal hypertension with two small varices although it is

extremely unlikely that these are the cause of iron deficiency anaemia.

There was no obvious source of bleeding throughout the remainder of her G.I. Tract.
