Eileen O'Hara has been seen for further review at the Clinical Haematology Unit on the 22nd July1997. Her condition is very much unaltered. An upper GI endoscopy had been performed on the 16th July 1997, which demonstrated evidence of portal hypertension with two small varices present, but no other abnormality was noted. No obvious source of bleeding was noted.

The current haematological parameters are relatively unaltered with a haemoglobin of 145g/l, a white count of $2.9_x10^9/l$ and a platelet count of $52_x10^9/l$. The haemoglobin A1C level stood at 9%.

I suggest that she continues on Ferrous Sulphate 200mgs twice daily and an appointment has been made for review on the 7th October 1997.
