- 3. Pulmonary hypertension
- 4. Atrial fibrillation
- 5. Cirrhosis related to Hepatitis C
- 6. Insulin treated Type II diabetes mellitus

This patient was in our wards recently for stabilisation of really quite severe cardiac failure. She was admitted as an emergency through the General Physicians and then transferred over to our care thereafter. She was very keen to go to her daughters wedding so we tried to stabilise everything as quickly as possible. She did remarkably well considering the extent of her cardiac problems. We confirmed pancytopenia which has been known about for some time. She had an excellent diuresis and eventually we were able to send her out on oral diuretic without any significant deterioration in left ventricular function. The creatinine before discharge was 97.

We will see her back at the clinic in the near future. Her medication is as outlined in my Resident's discharge letter.
