Dear Dr Davda

As you know this lady has already been accepted by Mr Dimitri from the point of view of mitral valve replacement. Quite rightly he was anxious to know the state of her coronary arteries. She was therefore admitted for coronary angiography which was done uneventfully.

The aortic pressure was 110/60. Left ventricular function was good and there was no evidence of mitral incompetence. She does of course have significant mitral restenosis. Selective coronary angiography indicated normal coronary arteries. This therefore is very good news. She now goes forward to her mitral valve replacement and as I understand it Mr Dimitri would hope to operate round about October.

She should otherwise be continuing on her current lines.
