## SURGEON'S NOTES

OPERATION PERFORMED

SURGEON MR K ROBERTSON (HMCN)

OPERATION ERCP

MEDICATION Midazolam 5 mg, Pethidine 25 mg, Gentamicin 120 mg, Buscopan 40 mg

INDICATION Severe acute pancreatitis. Unfit for cholecystectomy. Completion of biliary sphincterotomy.

PROCEDURE As before it was extremely difficult to gain good position on the ampulla requiring the scope to be in the long scope position. The previous sphincterotomy was seen to be entirely dry from the point of view of bleeding. With difficulty cannulisation of the bile duct was achieved, there being preferential pancreatic duct cannulisation. Finally a normal cholangiogram was achieved and in keeping with the British pancreatic guidelines an over the wire sphincterotomy was performed using a sphincterotome.
