Midazolam 4 mg, Pethidine 25 mg, Buscopan 40 mg, Cefuroxime 1 gm and

Gentamicin 80 mg

**PROCEDURE** 

The duodenal mucosa was friable. The ampulla was initially difficult to identify. Once this was achieved it was a little hard - nubbin of an ampulla that would not accept a cannula despite repeated efforts. A cautious needle knife approach was undertaken with three separate efforts made without any significant bleeding. Following this it was elected that it would be safer to desist today, re-heparinize and return in two days.
