I saw Mrs O'Hara for review today and was pleased to hear that the severe pain she was having from her herpes zoster appears to be settling, although she still has some post-herpetic neuralgia. She is due to finish her Carbamazepine, and I have suggested that, once she has used up all the tablets, she stops it.

Since this episode of diabetes appears to have got a bit out of control, I have suggested to her that she increase her Gliclazide to 160mgs daily, and I will review her in three months' time, to make sure her diabetes comes back under control.

I note that her hepatic investigations have been deferred until her herpes has settled down. I see from her notes that she does have antibodies against hepatitis-C, presumably from her blood transfusions.

I am not sure of the exact significance of this, but perhaps this would explain why she has developed cirrhosis, which is presumably the diagnosis.
