Dear Doctor,

I would be obliged if you could see this 59 year old lady who gives a six month history of loose bowel motions occurring from 2 - 6 times per day. There is no blood or mucus and her weight is steady. Apart from some flatulence she has no other complaints. Over the past several months her L.F.T.s' have been abnormal, the last result done on 3.9.90 shows a Gamma G.T. of 47, AST of 108 and ALT of 160. She also has a reduced platelet count of 93 for some time now.

Past medical history - mitral valve disease with controlled atrial fibrillation and hysterectomy. Diabetes with diet control only.

Drug history - Warfarin 4 mg. per day and Digoxin 0.25 mg. per day.

She was taking a moderate degree of alcohol only to begin with, however on abstaining completely from alcohol the LFT's are still deranged. There is no previous history of liver problems in the past.
