Thank you for your helpful letter concerning Mrs O'Hara and the mildly deranged liver function tests on this patient.

From a cardiac point of view she remains well.

On examination she appeared well, was in controlled atrial fibrillation and her valve sounds were competent and there were no murmurs. Her chest X-ray showed gross cardiomegaly but this is not any different from previous examination.

I could not feel any hepatic enlargement today and I would suggest that if a repeat set of liver function tests still continues to show mild derangement either an ultrasound of her liver or a gastroenterologist opinion might be valuable. Certainly there was no evidence of cardiac failure to account for these changes.

She should continue on her current drug medication and will report back here in a year.
