I saw this patient for review at the Cardiology Clinic on the 22nd May. She is three months pregnant and feels well.

The cardiac rhythm is normal, rate 70 per minute, blood pressure 120/80. She has rheumatic heart disease with mitral incompetence and the physical signs of this are unchanged from September of 1967. I understand from the patient that you will be sending her to the ante-natal clinic here and her supervision from the cardiac standpoint can be arranged when this is done.

At the left posterior base there are pleural crepitations which are associated with the mitral valvotomy carried out in January, 1966.
