DIAGNOSIS;

- 1. Hepatitis C in second transplant
- 2. Fibrosing cholestatic hepatitis in current graft
- On combination treatment with hepatitis C with GCSF and EPO support

Current medication -

Valganciclovir 900 mg od Atenolol 50 mg od Amlodipine 5 mg od Tacrolimus 1 mg mane - 0.5 mg nocte MO- 7:5 Platelets-51.

I saw this gentleman in the clinic today. His major symptoms were that of fatigue and tiredness, but there were no other complaints. He continues on his anti-HBV treatment with EPO for support.

In the clinic today his weight was 79 kilos with a BP 132/82.

Bloods were taken in the clinic, but unfortunatley there was a processing error, and these did not reach the laboratory. He will therefore attend for bloods in

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Glasgow on 20th July, the results of which will be forwarded to us. A date will then be arranged for admission for further blood transfusion and on modification and treatment.
