DIAGNOSIS -

1. Hepatitis C and alcohol induced liver failure requiring transplant 2002
2. Recurrent hepatitis C requiring retransplant 4.2.04
3. Leaking entero-enterostomy 12 days post transplant requiring refashioning
4. On treatment with Interferon and Ribavirin

CURRENT MEDICATIONS -

Azathioprine 100 mg daily, Tacrolimus 1 mg mane, 0.5 mg nocte, Prednisolone 5 mg daily, Ranitidine 150 mg bd, Fluconazole 100 mg mane, Atenolol 50 mg mane, FESO4 200 mg tds, Ganciclovir 1 g tds, Cotrimoxazole 480 mg mane, Amlodipine 5 mg mane, Ribavirin 200 mg mane, 400 mg nocte, Interferon 90 ug weekly and EPO twice weekly.

RESULTS -

sodium 141, potassium 4.5, urea 9.2, creatinine 88, Hb 11.9, wcc 2.1, platelets 201, bilirubin 69, ALT 160, GGT 420, alk phos 117, albumin 31, Tacrolimus 10, glucose 6.8.

I saw Victor in the transplant clinic. He is feeling tired and generally lacking in energy. His wife describes him as grumpy but he himself does not feel depressed. He has had no major flu like symptoms. He has had diarrhoea since starting Interferon, opening his bowels three times a day. There is no oedema. Overall today Victor looked unwell. This is largely likely to be due to his hepatitis C treatment which has been given in an effort to reduce the risk of a further rapid deterioration in his second transplant.

His bloods were discussed following clinic the Ribavirin was increased to 400 mg

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bd. He should continue otherwise and will be reviewed in two weeks' time in the Thursday clinic.
