DIAGNOSIS;

1. Hep C and Alcohol induced liver failure requiring transplant 2002
2. Biliary leak and stricture
3. Recurrent hepatitis C related to cirrhosis
4. Decompensated hepatitis C related cirrhosis
5. Re-transplant - 04/02/04
6. Post-op complicated by peritonitis due to leaking entero-enteostomy 12 days post transplant requiring re-fashioning of entero-enterostomy

Current medication -

Iron Sulphate
 Ganciclovir 1 gram tds
 Calcium Resonium 15 grams tds
 Cotrimoxazole 480 mg od
 Tacrolimus 1.5 mg bd
 Azathioprine 100 mg od
 Prednisolone 15 mg od
 Atenolol 50 mg od
 Tramadol 100 mg tds
 Ranitidine 150 mg bd
 Fluconazole 100 mg od

Results - Sodium 138, Potassium 5.0, Urea 13.4, Creatinine 116, Haemoglobin 112, WCC 6.9, Platelets 201, Bilirubin 25, ALT 246, GTT 730, ALP 442, Albumin 28, Tacrolimus 12.

On review today Mr Tamburrini remained well, although his BP was noted to be elevated at 178/110. His abdomen was soft non-tender, no masses were palpable. Mr
