11 September 2003

This 46 year old man was admitted on the 2 September 2003 for elective ERCP and stent removal. He had had stent insertion in March 2003 for bile leak and anastomotic biliary stricture.

The procedure was uneventful and revealed a stricture still present at the upper third of the common bile duct and no stent in situ.

In light of this gentlemen stable LFTs we have not planned any further intervention at this point but we will continue to monitor and intervene as necessary.

In light of his low white count of 2.6 his Azathioprine was reduced to 25 mg daily. We shall see him back in clinic in 1 months time.
