You may remember this gentleman with hepatitis C and a suspiciously rising alphafetoprotein. I gather further imaging and laparoscopic ultrasound by yourselves in March were unremarkable however, his recent repeat alphafetoprotein with ourselves has now risen again to 640 (535 in February and 366 in December). He himself is well apart from some lethargy and has been abstinent from alcohol for five months. You had planned to repeat his triple phase CT in the summer and I wanted to ensure this is in the system to occur shortly in view of the continued rise in his alphafetoprotein.
